EYFS Nursery & Reception	Expressive Arts and Design (Being Imaginative and Expressive) Throughout the year, children sing a range of well-known nursery rhymes and songs. Children perform songs, rhymes, poems and stories with others, and (when appropriate) try to move in time with music. They will learn how to play instruments with control and be able to sing play and perform.					
Nursery	Sing and remember simple songs and nursery rhymes linked to seasons/celebrations. Begin to move to a steady beat. Begin to explore musical instruments.		Sing, remember and begin to sing longer songs and nursery rhymes. To sing entire songs. To identify the pitch and melodic shape (up/down). Play an instrument with increasing control.
