LKS2 Parents' Evenings

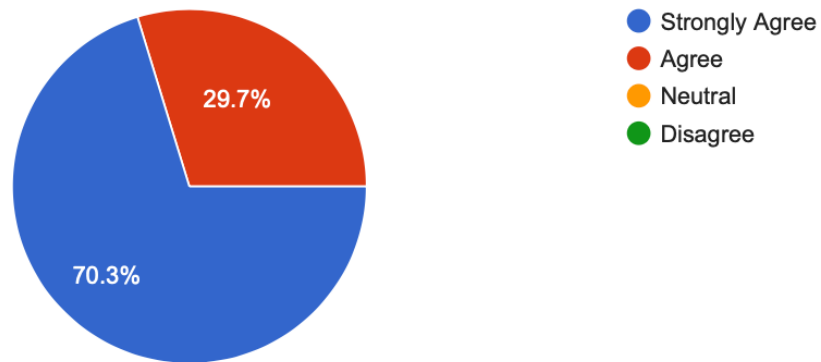

Of the parent responses, 100% of parents agree or strongly agree that their children have

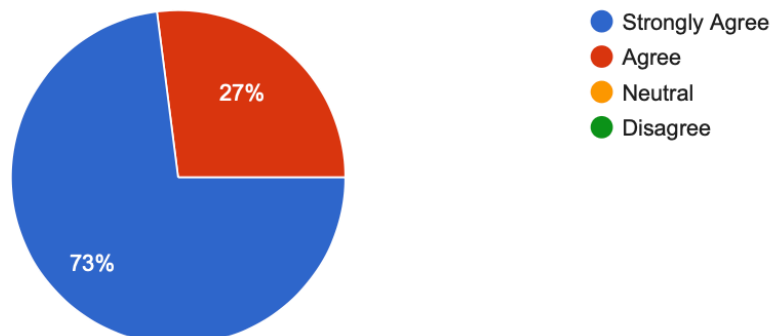
My child has settled in well to the new school year.

My child is happy in school.

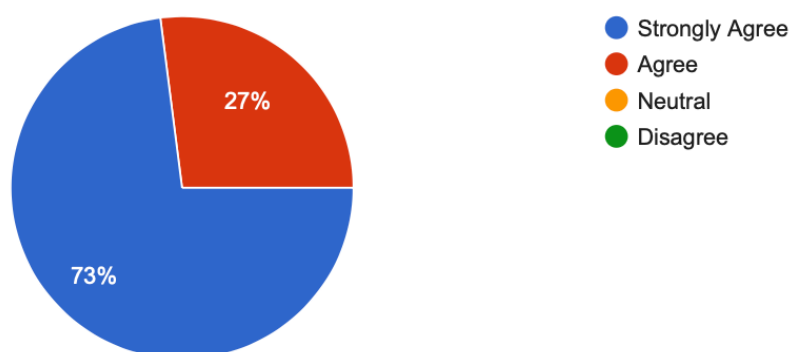
My child is happy in school
